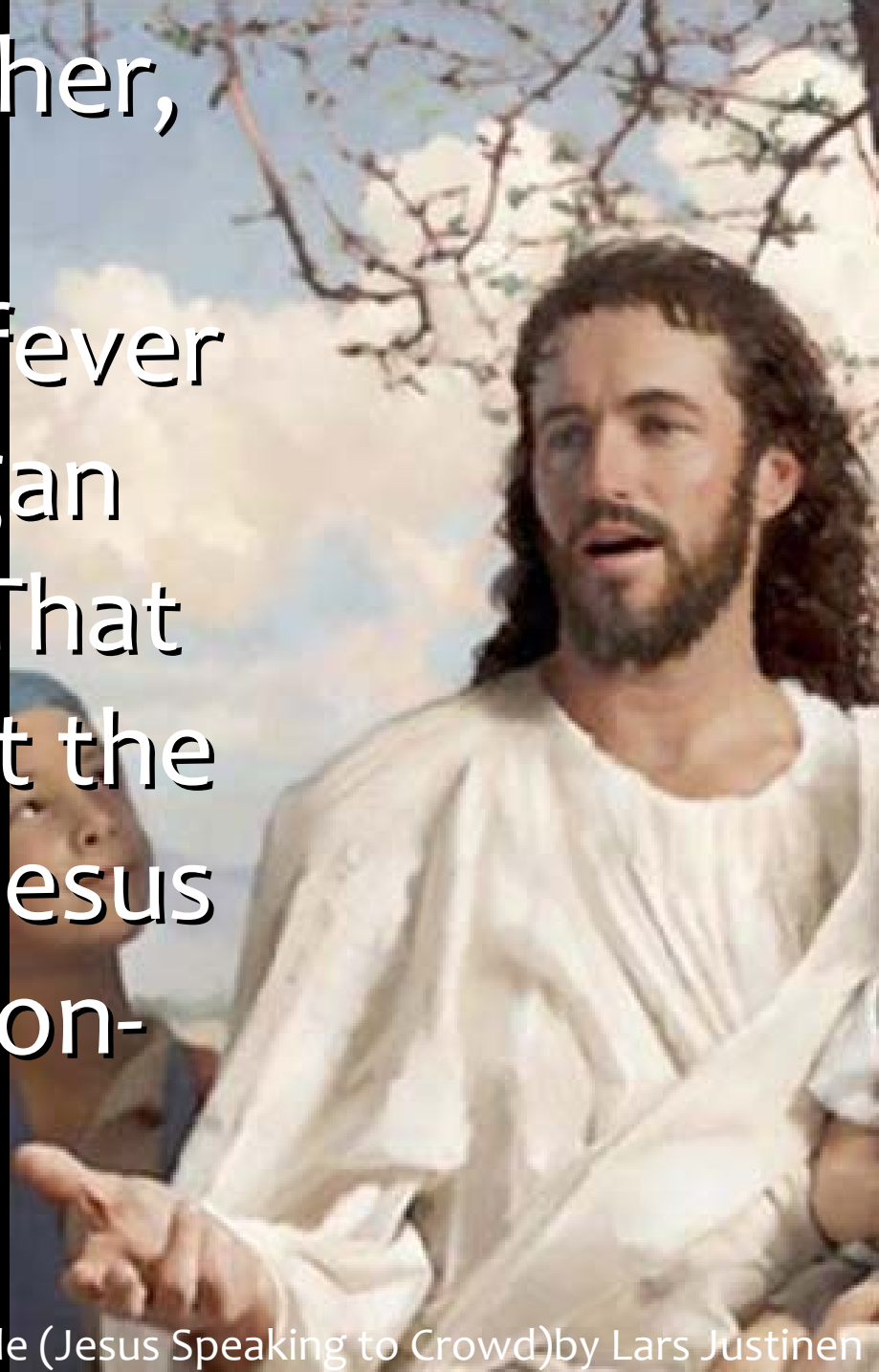

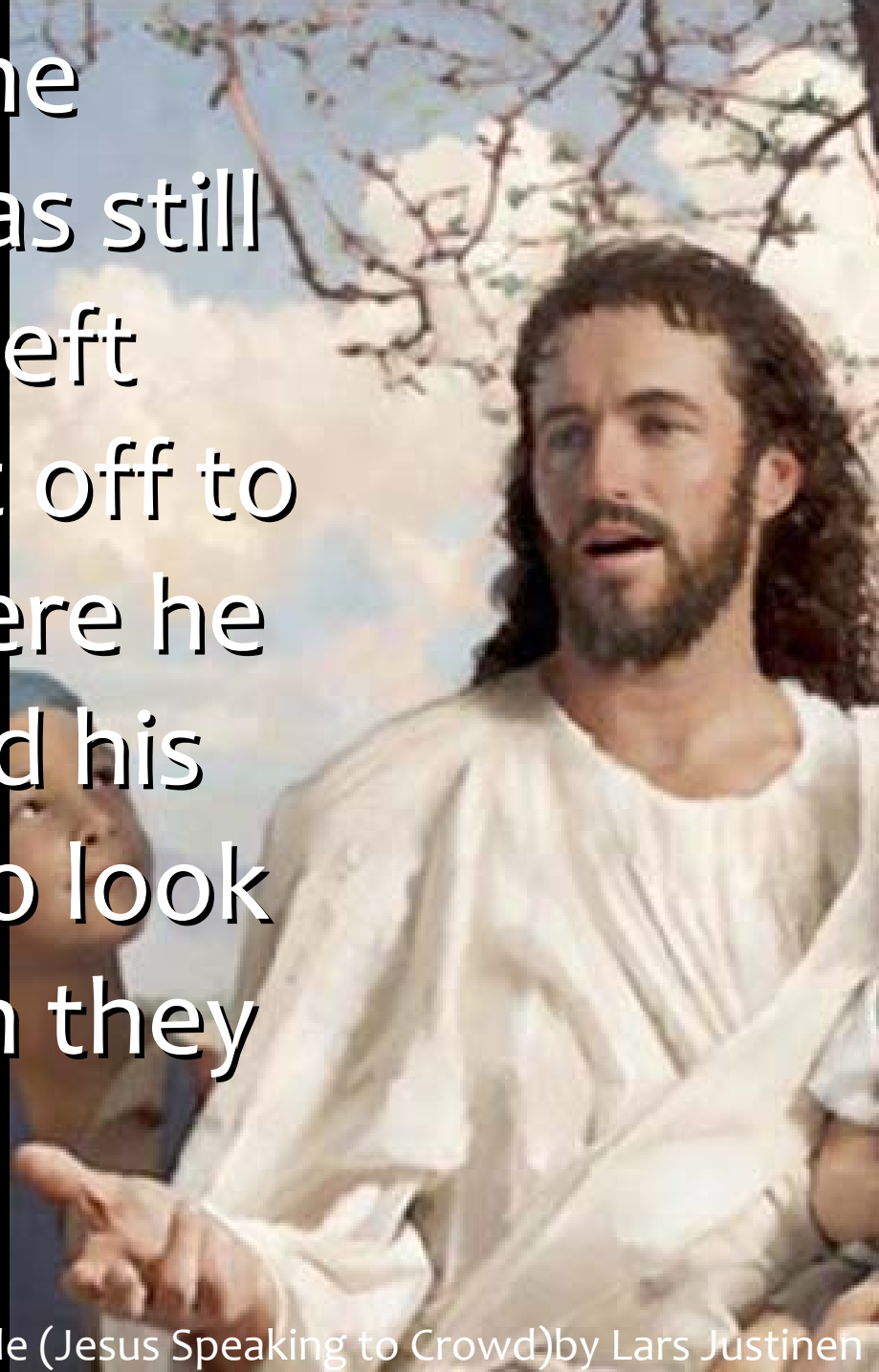
Mk 1:31 So he went to her,

Mk 1:33 The whole town gathered at the door, ³⁴ and Jesus healed many who had various diseases. He also drove out many demons, but he would not let the demons speak because they knew who he was.



Mk 1:35 Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. ³⁶ Simon and his companions went to look for him, ³⁷ and when they found him, they exclaimed:

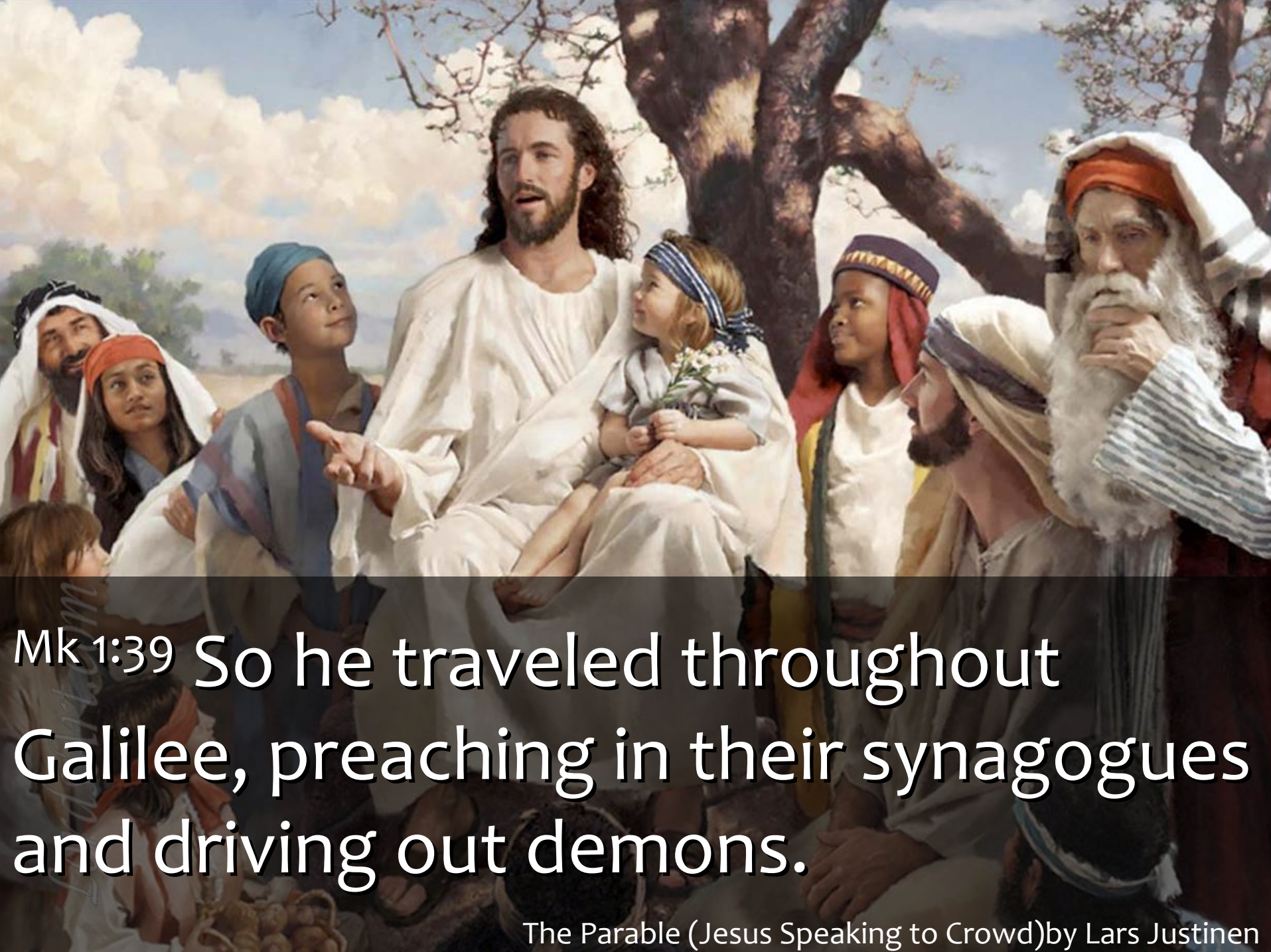


“Everyone is looking for you!”

nourish your soul..." Joel 2:23 MSG*

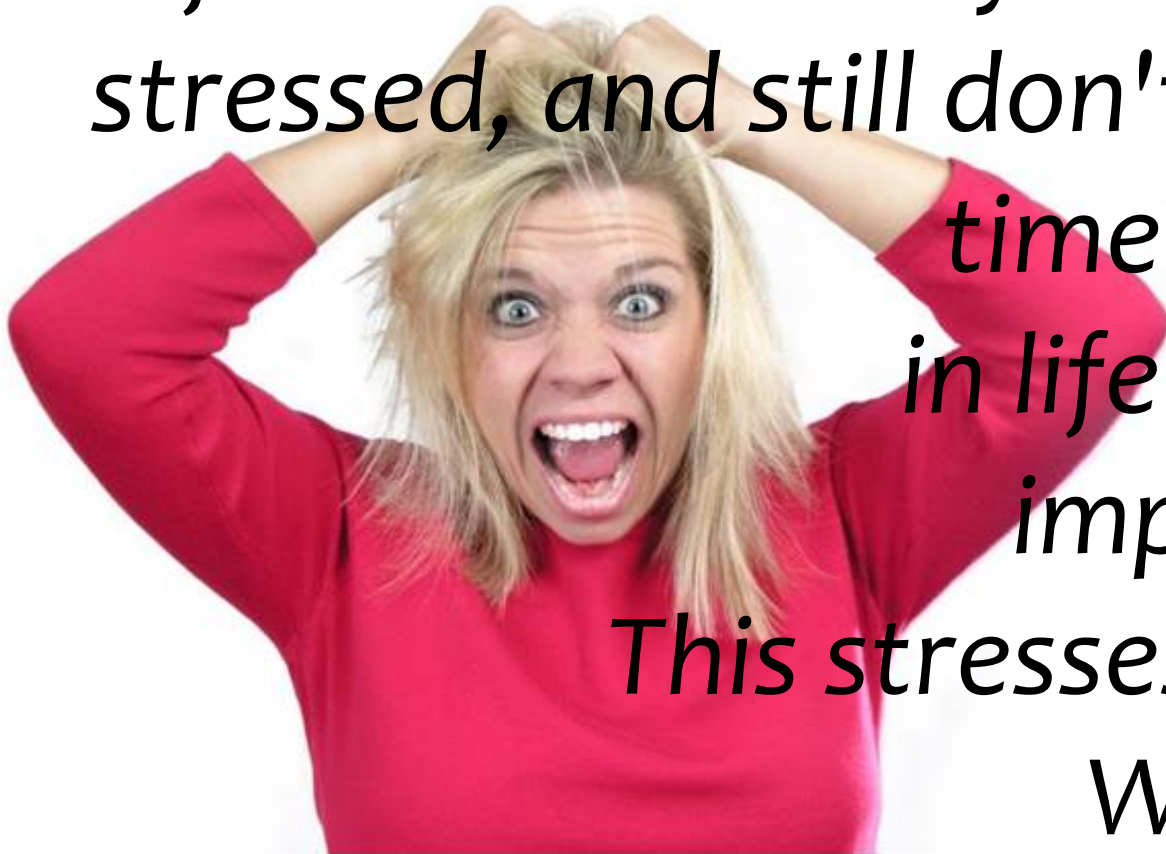
Memory verse:

"I feel like I'm always rushing, always stressed, and still don't have enough time for the things in life that are most important to me. This stresses me out a lot. What can I do?"

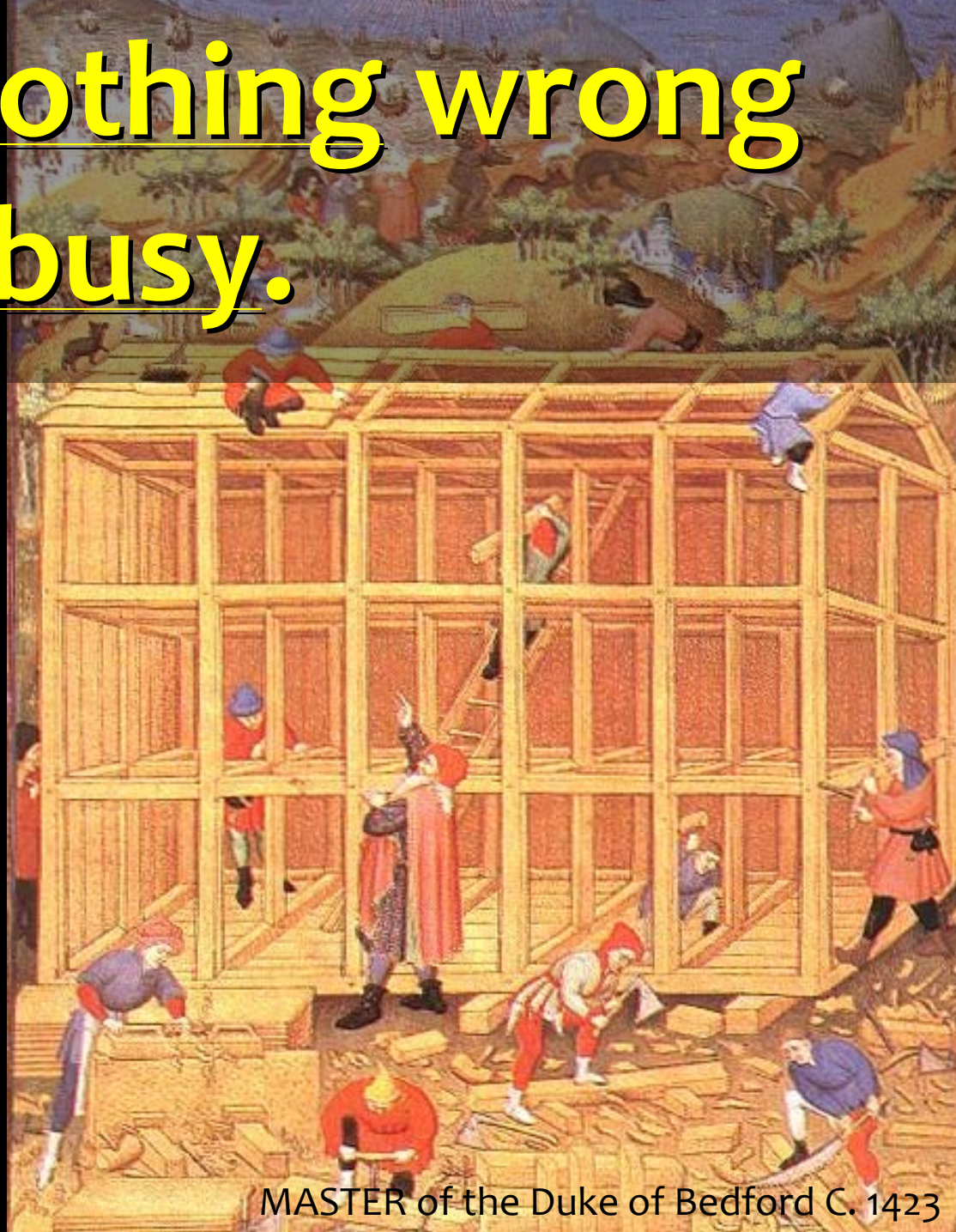


1. An overburdened Christian is an oxymoron.

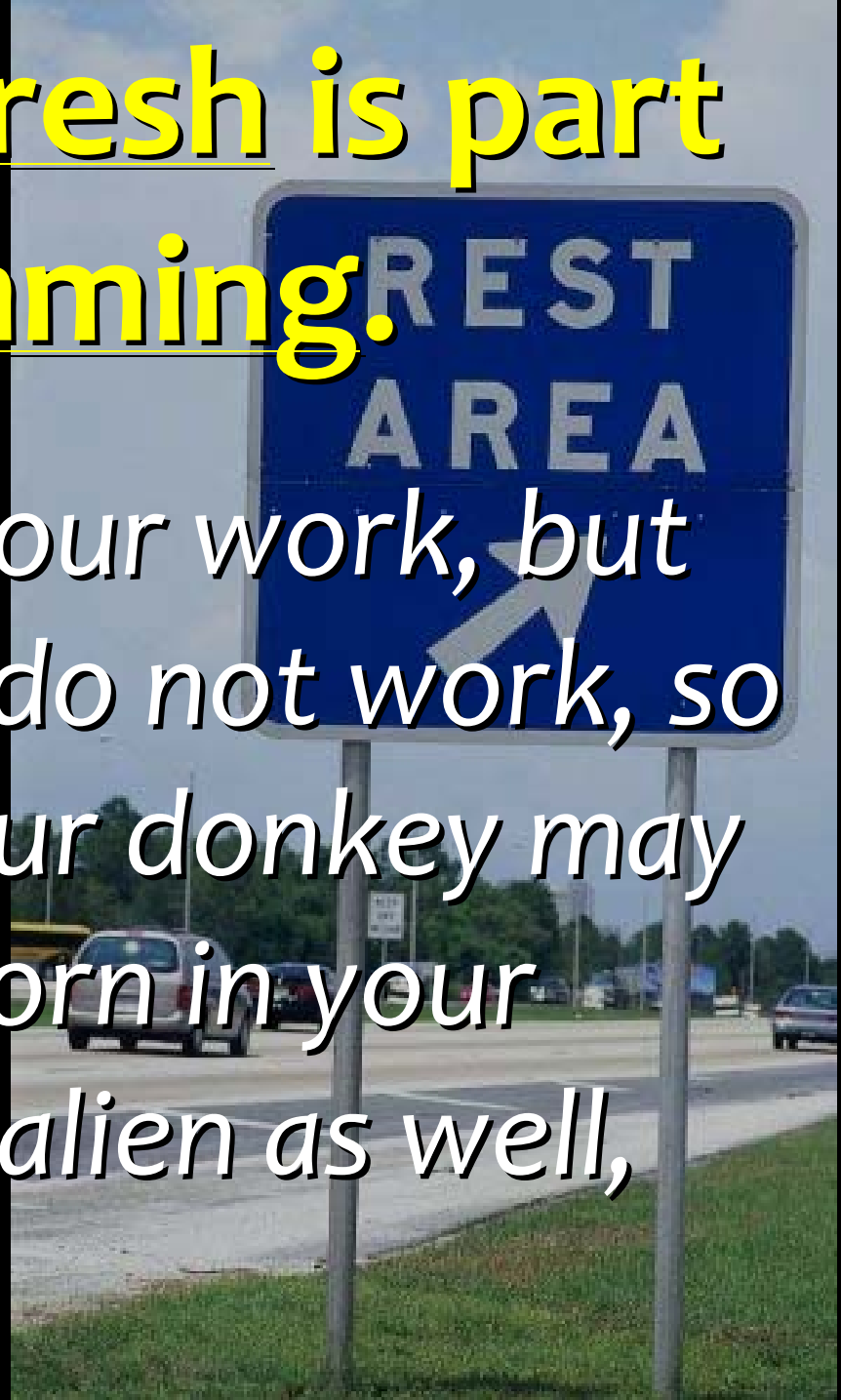
2. There's nothing wrong with being busy.

time.

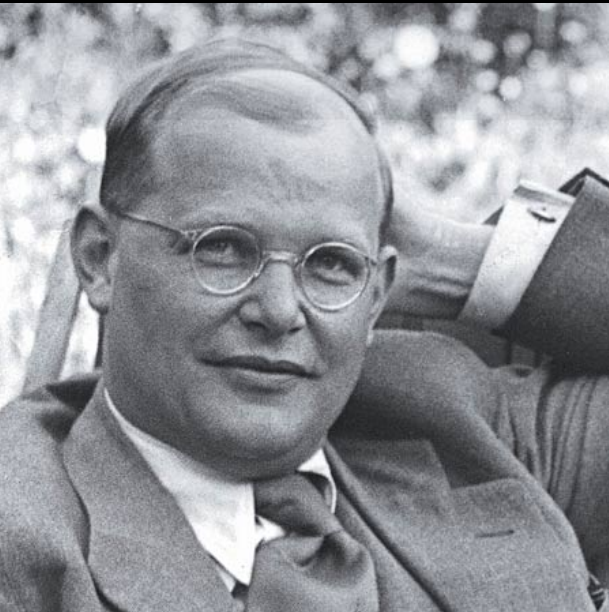
*Mk 1:35 Very early in the morning,
